### **Update on Chromebooks**

### **First Lego League**

- 1) Summer Program: The summer program allowed about 9 children a week to have fun, learn how to code an EV3 robot, and complete tasks on an FLL table. About 12 different children participated in at least one meeting with most attending regularly throughout the program. Most of the participants have since signed up for the upcoming FLL season.
- 2) FLL Registration (the older kids): FLL Registration opened on August 10th and allows for 10 participants, we've had 12 sign up as of August 27th. One decided to participate on Cawley's team and the other is on a wait list. The first 8 people signed up on the first day.
- 3) FFL Junior Registration (the younger kids): FLL Jr signup started on August 14th. As of August 29<sup>th</sup> about 15 children signed up and 2 parents interested in coaching so far. The first meeting is September 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm. Grace believes that we'll have a lot more signups before the first meeting (especially when school starts in September; that's when people remember to sign up for FLL Jr.).
- 4) Increased Registration Fees:
  - a. Jim is not aware of any negative impact to the FLL program resulting from the increase in registration fees. He has not heard any talk about the fees, either positive or negative.
  - b. Grace feels that people seem to think \$25 (the new FLL Junior registration fee) is very fair, especially when they know the cost of the kits. Feedback has mostly been surprise that it's so low, even when people purchase their Hooksett library card.
